
Support of Agreement: Waiver Request


The Centinela Valley Union High School District (CVUHSD) will schedule online courses through the Centinela Valley Union High School District Adult School for the 2009 Summer Session.




Support of Agreement: Workday Minutes

In accordance with the verbal agreement made at the bargaining table on May 21, 2009 and to ensure clarity, the Centinela Valley Union High School District (CVUHSD) recognizes that the Centinela Valley Secondary Teachers Association (CVSTA) enters into this agreement with the understanding that efforts will be made to create a maximum 388 minute workday, but if a shorter workday can be realized, every effort shall be made to achieve this goal. In addition, it is understood that shortened or minimum days will include a breakfast before the school day and a lunch period, but not a nutrition period.
