Base JROTC instructor pay is specific to an individual JROTC instructor and is determined by the US Department of Defense (DOD). As JROTC instructors work under contract between the DOD and the District, instructor pay shall be published on an annual basis when the District is notified
by the DOD of salary changes. Should a JROTC Instructor qualify for CVUHSD Salary Schedule A, they shall be paid the higher of the two rates.

Instructor Pay Calculator (Per Navy JROTC website, September 2018):
D Minimum Salary. Personnel employed shall receive a salary at least equal to the difference between their retired pay and the active duty pay and allowances, excluding incentive pay, which they would receive if ordered to active duty. The institution is the employing agency and shall pay the full salary due to the individual employed. The amount reimbursed to the school is one-half of the minimum salary for each instructor.

D Minimum Salary Changes. The minimum salary for instructors normally changes at least two times per year. The adjustments are based on changes in active duty pay and allowances, retired Consumer Price Index adjustments, and when the Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) for a geographic area is adjusted. In any case, NSTC will provide schools and individual instructors with written notification of changes as they occur
