



NOTICE OF ELECTION DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY CVSTA Leadership for 2021-22

Nominations are now open for next year’s CVSTA leadership. Officers and Representatives are crucial to good communication and advocacy for local chapters. Any active CVSTA member is eligible to be a candidate. Use the form below to declare your candidacy.

Election timeline:

- Any CVSTA member may file a Declaration of Candidacy form. **Email your intention to cvsta@sbut.org by May 4, 2021 at 4:30pm. If you do not have access to email, you may U.S. mail the form to the office** as long as it reaches the office by **Tuesday, May 4, 2021 at 4:30pm**. The office will e-mail a confirmation to your personal email address upon receipt of a Declaration form (be sure to include your email address below). **If you do not receive a confirmation, please follow up with the office to be sure your name is included on the ballot.**
- **A secure electronic ballot will be prepared and sent to the personal email address on file at the union office on Friday, May 7, 2021.** Ballots will be accepted through Monday, May 17th.
- **Any member who would prefer a paper ballot may request one by May 7th.**
- **Any member for whom the union offices does not have an email address will receive a paper ballot to the address on file at the union office. Paper ballots must be returned to the office by Monday, May 17th.**
- Ballots will be counted on Monday, May 17th. Results of the election will be announced and posted on the CVSTA website on May 17th.
- If a run-off election is necessary, ballots will be prepared and distributed by **Thursday, May 20th**. Run-off ballots will be due by May 27th at 3:30pm. Results will be announced and posted by May 27, 2021.
- Challenges to the election must be received in the office by **May 27, 2021** in accordance with CVSTA Standing Rules. Challenges to the run-off election must be received in the office by **June 6, 2021**.

Rep responsibilities include advocating for members at the school sites, being a liaison between Rep Council and the school sites, attending monthly Rep Council meetings, distributing chapter mail, conducting chapter-related elections and surveys as necessary and encouraging others to get involved in chapter leadership
