## HIGHLAND AVENUE PROJECT

### RESURFACING SCHEDULED FROM THE END OF MARCH THOUGH THE END OF MAY

A minimum of one lane of traffic will be open in each direction at all times during construction except during the 1 or 2-day period when the surface layer of asphalt is placed from 15th Street to Rosecrans Avenue. The roadway south of Rosecrans Avenue is too narrow to accommodate two lanes of traffic during paving operations. During paving south of Rosecrans, the dominant direction of traffic will be maintained (northbound in the morning and southbound in the afternoon) with the other direction detoured. All traffic lanes will be opened to traffic at the end of each working day. Although, every effort will be made to mitigate traffic impacts during construction, traffic disruption will be unavoidable. It is recommended that alternate routes be used if possible.

It is understood that parking on Highland Ave. is of significant importance to Highland Ave. businesses and residents; however, parking will be prohibited from time to time during the project. The contractor will be required to do much of the work in phases such that as much parking will be available during the day as possible. All parking spaces will be available after working hours. Parking restrictions will be posted 72 hours prior to

the work period. Please observe all parking restrictions as this will help complete the project more quickly.
