

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between the

and the
Centinela Valley Secondary Teachers Association

Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend

The Centinela Valley Union High School District ("CVUHSD") and The Centinela Valley Secondary Teachers Association ("CVSTA") desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding a **Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend** for the 2020-2021 school year:

Qualifying Service: To qualify for the **Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend**, a unit member must:

- 1) Be in possession of a valid teaching credential;
- 2) Be assigned as a teacher of at least one Special Education section; and
- 3) Be assigned as the case manager of at least one Special Education student

Unit Members in receipt of the Article 3.10 (CBA Board Approval Date of June 23, 2020) Special Education Stipend of \$800.00 shall receive an additional \$400.00 Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend per semester of Qualifying Service (total of \$1,600).


All other Unit Members shall receive a Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend of \$800.00 per semester of Qualifying Service (total of \$1,600).

No Unit Member shall receive more than a total of \$1,600.00 from the Special Education Classroom Teacher Stipend, the Article 3.10.2 Special Education Stipend, or any combination of the two for the 2020-2021 school year.

This MOU shall not constitute a past practice or serve as a precedent.

The terms of this memorandum shall be effective as of December 4, 2020, and shall expire on June 11, 2021.
