Budget Issues

- ◆ California State Budget needs to address a \$42bil shortfall.
- ◆ For PVPUSD, this means in the next 18 months (remainder of 08/09 calendar and 09/10) the district will need to address a \$7mil shortfall.

What we know for 08/09:

- ◆ There will be NO mid-year certificated cuts.
- ◆ You will be paid per your contract. District will make 08/09 payroll.
- ◆ The school year will NOT be shortened by five (5) days. CTA strongly opposes such a plan.
- ◆ Categoricals will be freed to allow flexibility in making a budget.
- ◆ 08/09: State will reduce funding by \$400/ADA

For 09/10:

- ◆ We are dependent upon the outcome of the budget in Sacramento.
- ◆ Based on the “worst-case” scenario the district will have to make cuts to cover the \$7mil shortfall.
- ◆ They have not decided on how these cuts are to be made.

- ◆ Your union's mission is to save jobs in these tough economic times.
- ◆ In on going meetings with the school board and district officials, our president has made it clear that should cuts be made to the teaching staff they will also need to be made in district personnel and administration.
