Notice of Election PVFA REPRESENTATIVES FOR 2010-2011

Nominations are now open for next year's PVFA site representatives. Reps are crucial to good communication and advocacy for local chapters. Any active PVFA member is eligible to be a candidate. Use the form below to declare your candidacy.

Election timeline:

- Any PVFA member may file a Declaration of Candidacy form. Call, fax, e-mail or snail mail the PVFA office by May 7, 2010 at 5:00pm. The office will e-mail a confirmation upon receipt of a Declaration form.
- Ballots will be prepared and delivered to the school sites by Friday, May 14 for voting during the week of May 17-21 at school sites.
- Individual ballots will be mailed to members who are not at a school site. Any member may "vote by mail" by requesting a ballot by Friday, May 14, 2010.
- All ballots must be returned to the PVFA office by May 21 at 3:30pm, at which time the ballots will be tallied. (Ballots require a signature to be valid. Please do not place them in rep mailboxes).
- Results of the election will be announced and posted on the PVFA website by May 24, 2010.
- If a run-off election is necessary, ballots will be prepared and delivered the week of May 24-28 for voting the week of June 1-4. Run-off ballots are due to office by June 4 at 3:30pm. Results will be announced and posted by June 7.
- Challenges to the election must be filed by June 3, 2010 in accordance with PVFA Standing Rules. Challenges to the run-off election must be filed by June 17, 2010.

Reps responsibilities include advocating for members at the school sites, being a liaison between rep council and the school sites, attending monthly Rep Council meetings, distributing chapter mail, conducting Association-related elections and surveys, as necessary and encouraging others to get involved in Association leadership
